Event

The last event for the San Clemente Expedition for the year will be a river canoeing trip centered at Moabi Regional Park June 10th-12th. The weekend will be a great conclusion to the year!

Location

Camping for the trip will be at Moabi Regional Park in Needles, CA. The location is about 4½ hours from San Clemente, north of Lake Havasu. We are reserved at Site #15 on the peninsula. Please be prepared for hot days on the water and cool evenings. Please note that there is a parking fee of \$15 per car per day which is not covered in the fee, plan on carpooling! Please park in marked overflow parking (near P16).

Take I-5, Exit 133N, Merge onto 241N, Take 91E toward Riverside, Exit 15N toward Barstow, Continue on 40E toward Needles, Take Exit 153 Park Moabi Drive, Turn Left onto Park Moabi Drive, Location will be on the Left

Schedule

We plan to arrive on Friday between 4:00-6:00pm. Please notify your circle leader if you will be late so that camping space is prepared.

Saturday we will be leaving camp at 8:30am via bus to canoe from Needles back to the camp site at Moabi (4hr trip). The canoeing company will be providing transportation up to Needles. Camp gear remains on site. Saturday afternoon will be open for fishing and hikes. Saturday night will be campfire.

Sunday canoeing will start at 7:30am from the camp site at Moabi to Castle Rock (6hr trip). The boat company will provide transportation back from Castle Rock to camp. Camp gear needs to be packed up before canoeing on Sunday to make the check-out time.

Fee

The fee is \$68 per person or \$85 with the 2010/2011 San Clemente official t-shirt. The fees will cover the camping reservation, canoeing for 2 days, patch, lunch Saturday & Sunday, and dinner Saturday. Please make plans for your own meals Friday evening and for breakfast Saturday & Sunday.
